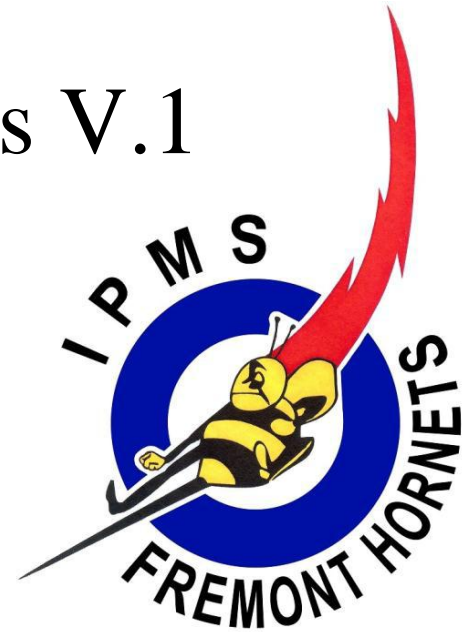

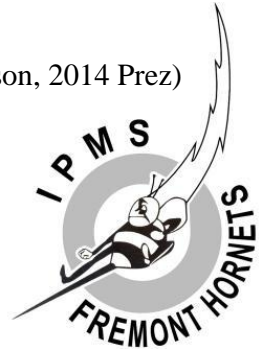

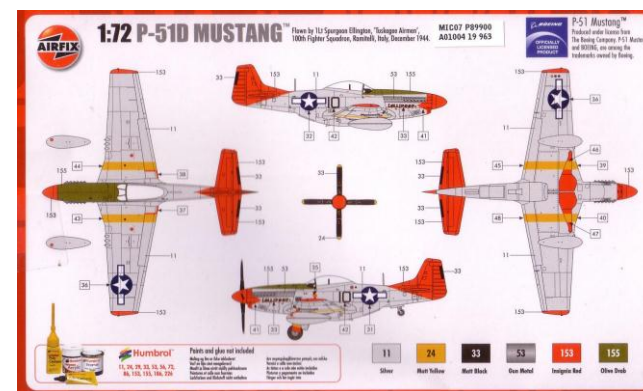
1) **MUST USE ANY EDITION OF THE NEW MOLDING OF 1/72 AIRFIX “D”**

3) YOU MAY BUILD ANY OR MANY AS YOU WISH. ONE IS GOOD, MORE IS A GRAND THING, NONE IS FINE, TOO.

4) ANY SCHEME REAL OR NOT IS FINE **NOT LIMITED** to **OUT OF BOX**, etc.

5) **FREE HORNETS ONLY, MAY PLAY.**
