





and armed HMMWV.










Far left, Cliff's Messerschmitt Me-328B in 1/72. Above, winged A-4b

Sean Fallesen, Free Hornet and Orange County IPMS member, works his USS Delaware on !








Dave even shared with us how he had made tidy work of "securing" model.
