October 24 2019 – Last publish date of the Fremont Hornets Buzz V.1, issue #87 (Buzz\_88)

November 2019 – Free Hornets meet regularly at usual locale, but no minutes taken, still a Model of the Month winner was recorded with then intent to publish one more Buzz in 2019

December 2019 – Free Hornets meet for their traditional Holiday Party and Burton manages to hornswoggle several into playing a modified for modeler purposes, competitive word game based on German "Stadt/Land/Fluss". Ten members show it can be done and successfully. A record is made of who won but sadly, it's lost now and no accountability may be established.

January, February 2020 – Free Hornets continue to meet at usual locale, but horizon already has ominous portent of no more meetings soon perhaps as this "COVID-19" issue seems to have a real constrictive potential, and already has taken down NNL West 2020 (January) and (February) Silver Wings Silvercon 2020 public events which had been in place for months.

March 2020 – Everything begins to come to an abrupt halt. The SVSM SV Classic #7 which was under the able leadership again of Free Hornet Mike Woolson was cancelled for the 1<sup>st</sup> of 3 times. The Free Hornets TriCity 14 which was trying to get underway for 2020 after hiatus in Fall 2019, became moot point to pursue for time undeterminate. Fresno Scale Modelers had to cancel their 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Show for time undeterminate. 


