- 1) This is a sample of two completed “gambits” for Editor’s offered Holiday Game Night
- 2) The categories for columns 4 thru 8 normally would be decided by players at time of play but since the Editor (and Club) have no time to spare, he’s chosen “likely broad appeal” Subjects and then input qualifiers for each to provide more meat for rules given below:
 - A. An English Alphabet character is chosen to begin word selection filtering for each
 - B. Each player competes to come up with at least ONE EACH, competition begins when all are done or give up trying. 10 points for each FIRST USE term by a player, 5 points for those who don’t have any extra plays and have a “repeat use” term for that column. Max total per gambit is 80, no extra
 - C. Awards will be given for at least First, Second and Third if 3 or more play the game through allotted time, based on total points at end of game. Clarification & detail discussion will be given an opportunity before game is underway, in case you have interest to play but not sure of what this is.

Although it's more phone fun actually, and all that will remain "under wraps"

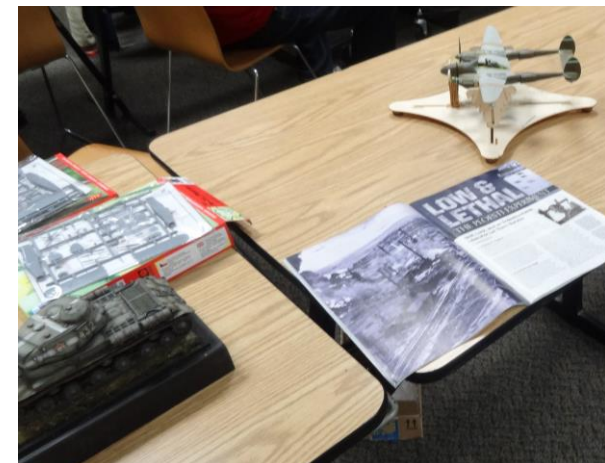


