
The Free Hornets have had now 14 TriCity Classics, 11 of them consecutively using a fine simple "Movie/Geography" framing plot that began with "The Italian Job" movie and focused on Italy, Italian items.


The Contest Director chose to use the planned 2018 theme of which was going to get ahead of any and all who were going to celebrate the 50th annum of the Apollo Moon Landing. Long ago, two Free Hornets had idea we should do a "Lunacy" theme which inspired this Director to find a way (this way) to work it.

So, finally, a chance to run the gamut, anything Space Related real or fictional, and have fun.

Some of the fun the Contest Director had on the way to delivering the event can be seen here. Examples of the 1/2/3 awards designs devised, with original art for the first printings of Jules Verne's book (published in 1865!!) which formed the basis of the 1958 Movie of the same title, and the brilliant 1998 HBO Miniseries with again the same title, all influenced what he did. One of the key areas for this event was a solution to properly expanding the Real Space category from traditional single one into a reasonable grouping, seeking to actually gain some entries. After all, the 4 divisions seen below would otherwise have to be where the entrants would all funnel, so essentially a Saturn V rocket assembly could be competing with an Apollo LEM, a Gemini Capsule, a Mercury Redstone, a Voyager deep space vehicle, a Sputnik and a Skylab, with a Lunar Rover tossed in. Oh yes, you may answer, you could just split category at the show on that day to solve this. Optimist, rarely the time or folks Available to properly perform this feat, and ever more rarely that Real Space would get such attention. In any case, this was Contest Director's chance to try at least, see what may come of it, and plan to repeat it once again perhaps in next TriCity.











When a nasty turn of events midstream (unexpected computer crash, backups scant) helped upset things, the Director had To attempt to expedite creating awards faster once data, research and plan was recovered. So examples like the simple NASA Meatball design became a method employed for awards less likely to be given out or where Space was irrelevant.

In other cases though, specific efforts were made to bring honor and respect to the theme, such as the two different usages of the NA X-15 craft. The black & white version shows a later veteran astronaut with the bird he flew before ending up in space proper. The color one shows a "local" who perished in the last flight of this extremely successful manned spacecraft, Michael Adams of Sacramento CA. Very likely those two awards in category would be given out at the TC-14, sought quality
